After logging into the ESP Website admin, locate your site and click on the Edit Site button.

When visitors view your site, they will be able to select the language from a dropdown in the upper right corner. All of the information on your site, including product information and the checkout process will be shown in the selected language.

The Product Option Assistant dropdown to select whether to use the Basic Version or skip this option (It is recommend that if the shopping cart is enabled you use the Basic Version).

The Content Control section enables you to control which product appear on your site. By default, the "Show All Products" checkbox is selected. If you do not wish to display all products on your site, use the available options to make your selections. For example, if you only wanted to show products that are made in the USA, uncheck the "Show All Products" checkbox, go to the Only Show Products column and select "That are Made In The USA". You are able to check multiple options if needed.

## Domains

When you purchase an ESP Website or Company Store, the domain provided will end in ".espwebsite.com" (for ESP Websites) and ".logoshop.com" (for Company Stores). All domains provided within the ESP Websites admin have an SSL certificate. To add an espwebsite or logoshop domain, click on the Add Domain button.

If you have a custom domain name, you are able to redirect it to your ESP Website or Company Store.

To add a domain name, click on the "Add New ESP Website Address or Custom Domain" button. Then, type your new domain name into the field and click on the Save button.

If you have multiple domains which point to the same page, unless a specific URL is designated as the default page, Google will select which URL to display in search queries, which can affect the SEO for your site. For example, if you had two URLs for your site: [www.companypage.com/espwebsite](#) and [www.companypage.espwebsite.com](#), but do not specify a default page, Google will toggle between the two URLs, meaning that the SEO traffic for your site will be split and proper weight will not be applied to ranking. By select a

default, Google will be directed into a single URL, allowing for proper identification of your site for SEO purposes.

## Redirect Your Domain

If you have selected to use a custom domain, you do not need to type "www." Just type the domain name – for example: ABCpromo.com.

You will need to set up a redirect to point your custom domain to your ESP Website. Contact your domain host (GoDaddy, Network Solutions, etc.) and have them redirect the domain name by pointing the A record to the provided IP address (**199.0.184.165**). You can redirect up to four (4) domain names.

**Update your IP address to complete process:**

- 1 Sign in** to your Internet Domain Registrar account  
(Example: GoDaddy, Network Solutions, etc.)
- 2** Locate the page for updating your domains **DNS records**.
- 3** Update your **A record** with the IP address for your website.

- 4** Save your changes and wait for site to update.

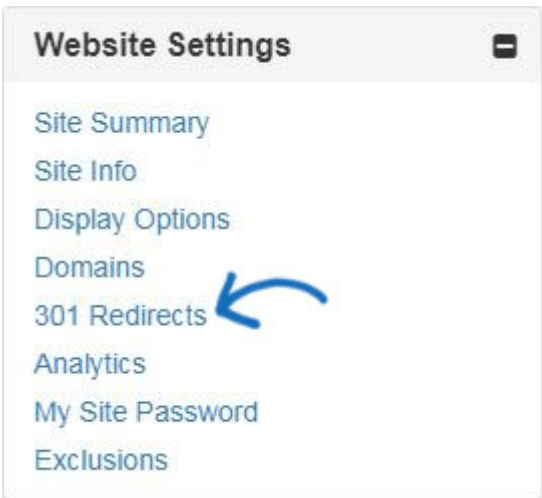

## 301 Redirects

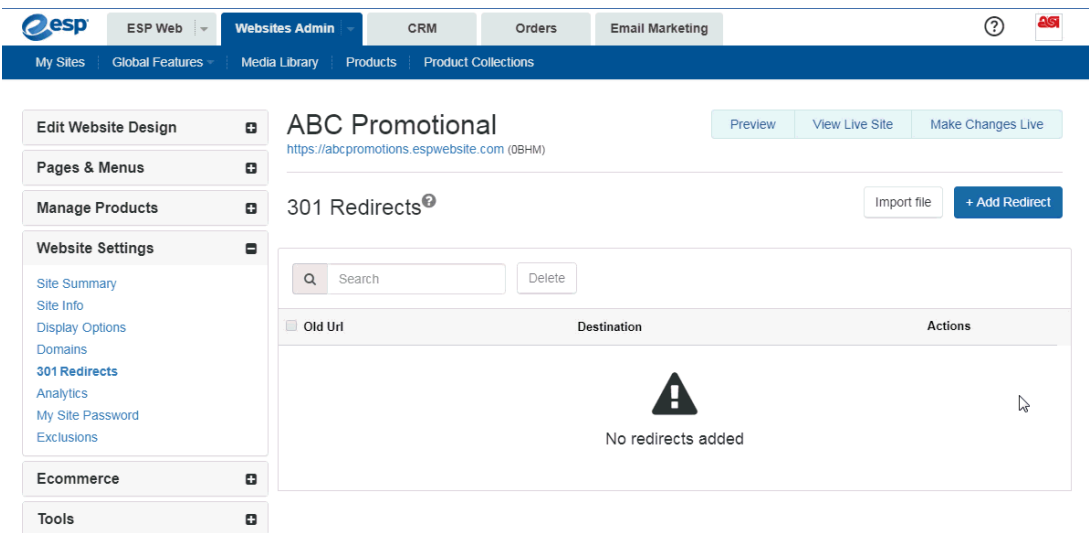
Using 301 redirects is important for ensuring the SEO ranking information for pages is maintained when moving pages from an old site to your new ESP Website. By using 301 redirects; rather than just recreating the page information on your ESP Website, the SEO weight and Google ranking for the web page will be preserved.



To establish a 301 redirect, log into the ESP Websites Admin and click on Edit Site for the ESP Website or Company Store. Go to the Websites Settings section and select 301 Redirects.



To enter a 301 Redirect, click on the Add Redirect button and type the original page URL and the new page URL.



If you have a large amount of pages to redirect, you can use the Import File button. Before importing the .csv file, it is important to ensure that the information is in the optimal format. In the file, Column A should list the old page's URL extension in this format: "oldpageextensionname". Do not include the full URL or ending (ex: .html, .asp, etc). Column B should list the page name from the ESP Website or Company Store in the same format. Do not include column headers.

Once you have finished preparing the file, click on the Import File button. Browse your computer to locate the file, select it, and then click on the Open button. Then, click on Import. The newly imported 301 redirects will be listed.

## Analytics

In the Analytics section, you can enable Google Tag Manager and Google Analytics.

If you have a Google® Tag Manager account and would like to link it to your ESP Website or Company Store, you can do so checking the "Enable Google Tag Manager Service" checkbox and then entering the Container ID in the available box.

## My Site Password

You are able to password protect your site by:

- Checking the "Enable Password Protection" box.
- Entering text in the "Password Prompt Text" box.
- Typing the password for your site in the password box. The maximum number of characters for a site password is ten (10).

When you are finished, click on Save and then click on the Make Changes Live link.

## My Site Password

Enable this feature if you want visitors to enter a password before viewing your site. This feature is useful in cases such as Company Stores that are intended for a private audience.

## Exclusions

Exclusions Lists enable you to remove products, categories, and even specific suppliers from your ESP Website or Company Store. To create a list, go to the Global Features dropdown and select Exclusion Lists.

After you have created an exclusion list, you can apply it to your site using the Exclusions option in the Website Settings area.

In this area, you can:

- Click an individual list or hold CTRL to select multiple lists, and then use the right pointing arrows to add these to the Selected List box.
- Use the double right pointing arrows to add all available lists to the Selected List box.
- Click an individual list or hold CTRL to select multiple lists in the Selected Lists, and then use the left pointing arrows to remove them from the Selected List box.
- Use the double left pointing arrows to remove all selected lists.

## Exclusions

### Product Suppression

To suppress products from this Website, move the set of products to be suppressed from the list on the left to the list on the right by highlighting and using the arrow buttons. Then click Save.

Because product IDs may change at any time these lists need to be reviewed and maintained regularly.

Click on the Save button when you are finished. Click on the Make Changes Live to publish these changes.

## Category Control

ESP Websites enables you to limit the categories on your site. Just like with product lists, click on a category from the options on the left and then click on the single arrow to move it onto the excluded list.

**Note:** A product that is listed multiple categories and one of the categories tied to the product is set as excluded from our site, that product will not appear in related categories.

### Category Control

This section allows you to control what categories appear on your Website. All categories are shown by default. To exclude a category, select it from the "Included" list on the left. Click the first arrow button in the middle and the category will move to the "Excluded" list on the right. Click the blue "Save" button.

**Note:** If a product is in more than one category, and one of the categories tied to the product is excluded, then that product will be excluded from the site for all related categories as well.

Click on the Save button when you are finished. Click on the Make Changes Live to publish these changes.

## Supplier Control

ESP Websites enables you to limit the suppliers shown on your site. In the Exclude a Company box, begin typing a supplier name or ASI number. The matching results will appear below and we can click on the "Add to Excluded List" button.

To remove a supplier from the Excluded List, hover on the supplier listing and then click on the "Remove from Excluded List" button.

### Supplier Control

This section allows you to control what suppliers appear on your Website. By default, all suppliers are shown. If you would like to exclude a supplier, type the supplier's name in the gray box; click the blue "Add to Excluded List" button; and click the blue "Save" button. Save button will only apply to the Supplier Exclusion section.
