

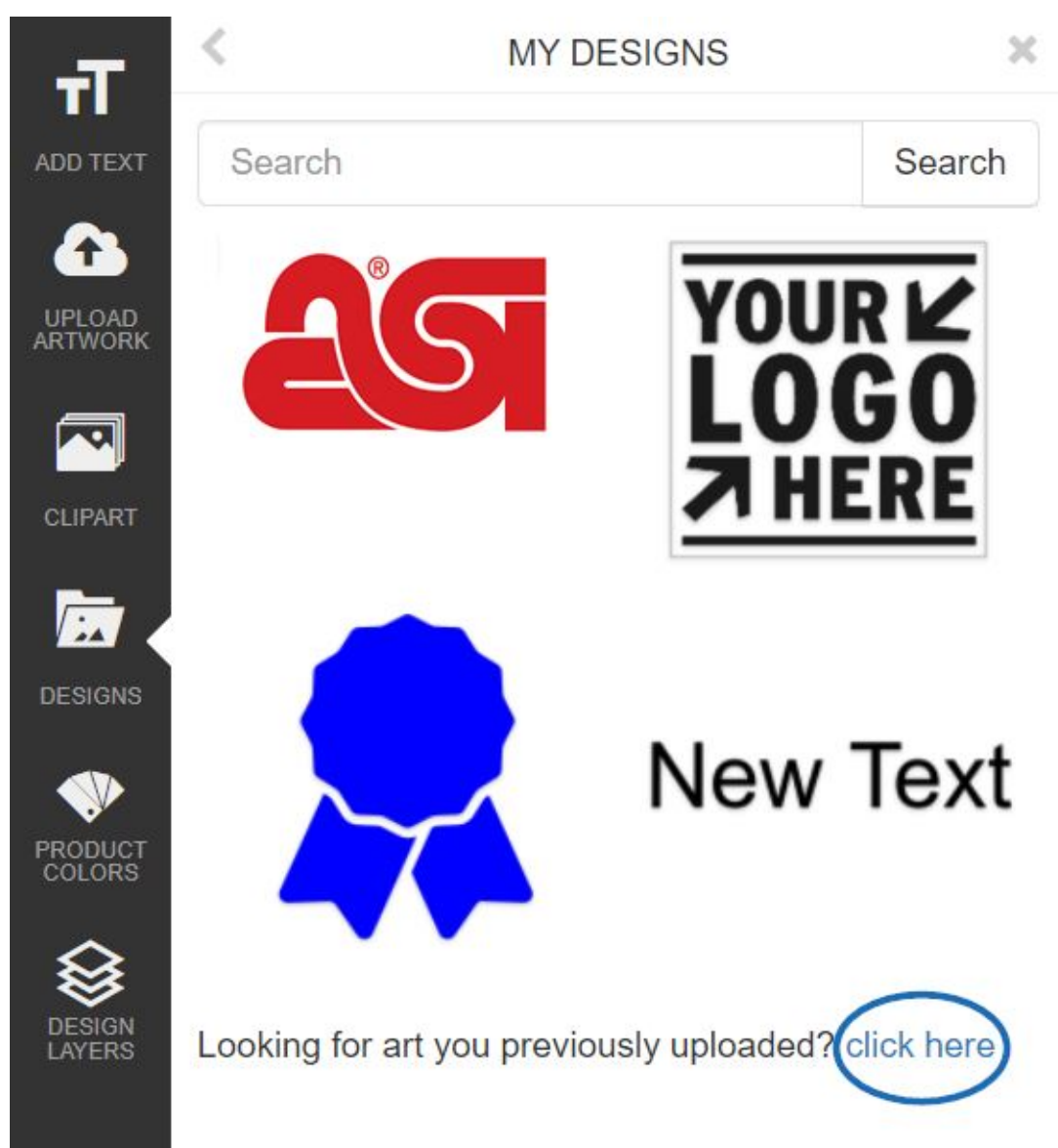

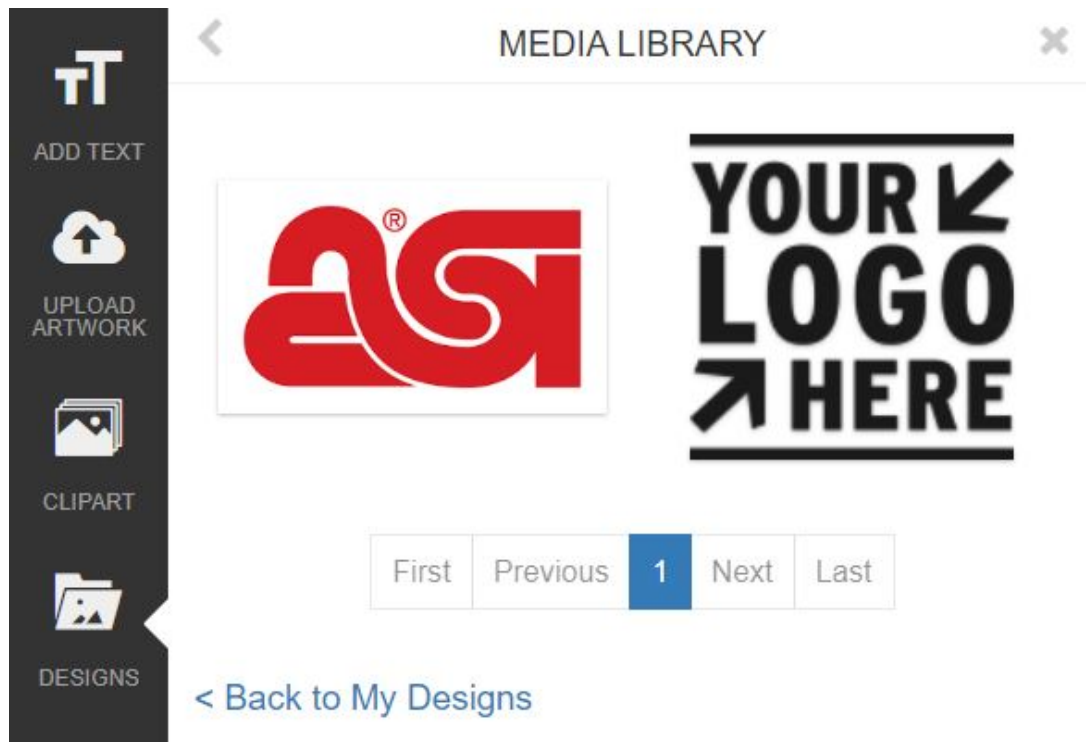

When creating Virtual Samples, artwork files are uploaded and saved in the Media Manager. You can view all uploaded files by clicking on the link in the Designs section.

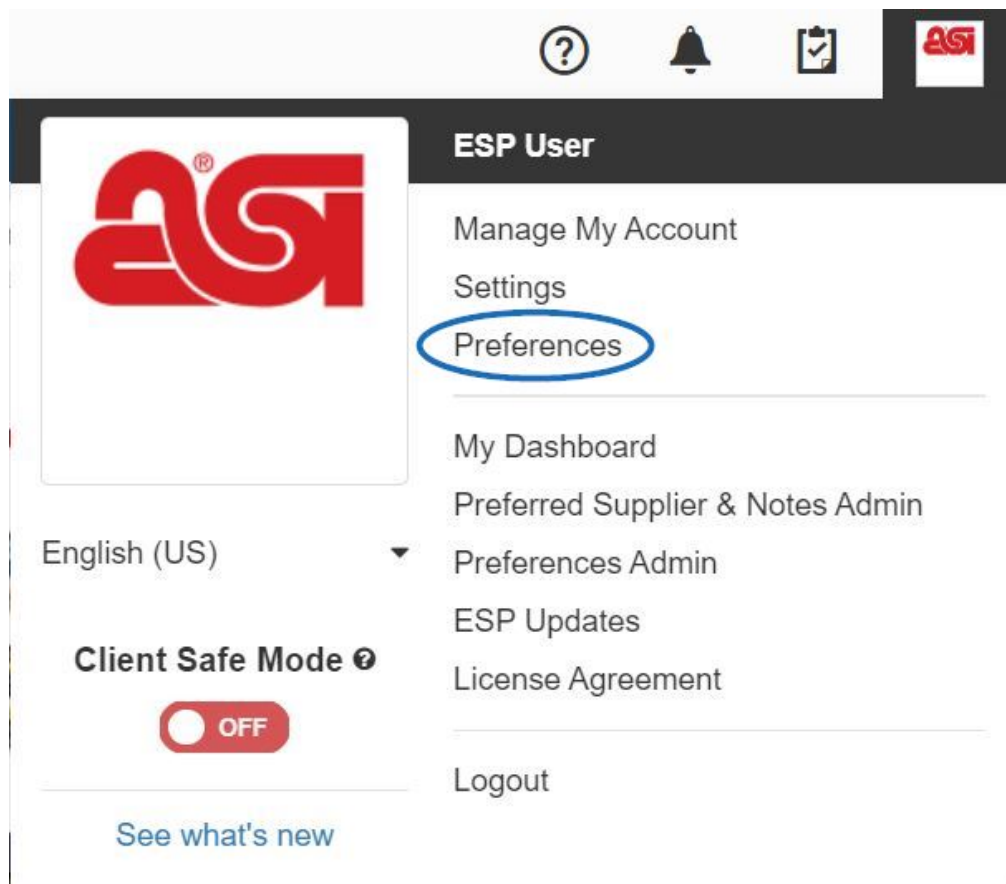


All previously uploaded artwork files will be available in this setion.



If you have uploaded an image file to the Design Studio but would like to remove it from the previously uploaded artwork section, take the following steps:


1. To access the Media Manager, click on the avatar (user icon) and then select Preferences.



2. In the Preferences window, go to the Virtual Samples tab and then click on the

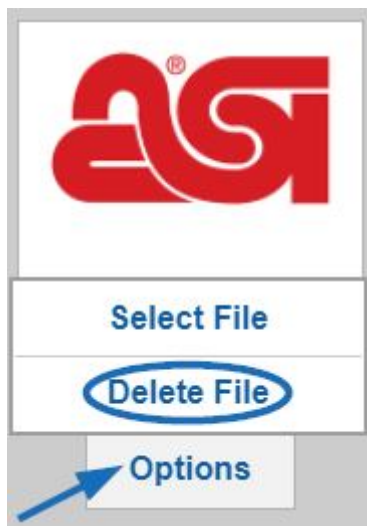
